Bill Heineke has proposed to have a WSAA Triple Crown along with our current State shoots. The State Association will ask Bill to bring up his proposal at the General Meeting with explanation on how it would work.

Randy Wahler proposed to have affiliated WSAA clubs and state members donate plaques they have won in the past to the WSAA. The plaques would be recycled for the purpose of the Young Adult, Youth, and Cubs. If you are interested in donating plaques contact Lynell, the State Secretary, to make arrangements. The WSAA will track how well the plaques go and them may take on trophies for the same purpose. If you think you might be interested in donating trophies, please contact Lynell.

The WSAA would like for all affiliated clubs to email a list of participants of their club members to Lynell. The State Secretary will then email all flyers and information regarding State shoots and local shoots from around the state to others that are not current NFAA/WSAA members. This will hopefully get more participation and individuals involved in the sport of archery.

Norm Tillman made a motion to have the State Shoots put on posters and the shoot schedule put on cards as was done last year. Randy Wahler seconded the motion and it was passed to make the posters and cards. The State Secretary will mail them out to the different archery shops.

The Sean Kostelecky Scholarship shoot was brought up and decided to not have any other shoots held on the same day. The date of the shoot is March 26 in Thermopolis. This is a benefit shoot and the money raised goes towards an archer looking at continuing their education. If you would like an application, contact your State Secretary or Randy Wahler. This scholarship is not limited to teenage archers.

Shooter of the Year will continue and everyone seems to be positive with how it is going. The results will be kept updated on the website. Possible changes to this program might be to charge 5.00 per adult person that wants to sign up for shooter of the year, with all the money going to the winner. This would be in addition to the \$200.00 that is already being paid out.
