Minutes of the Winter Meeting October 3, 2010

Present at the Winter Meeting held on October 3, 2010 was: Dan Kolb, Ted Walton, Dan & Michelle Perry, Shane Kinsel, Michael Bean, Larry Baker, Randy Wahler, Mark & Lynell Preston, Jeff Meyer, Robert Hearrell, Tom Bennett, Mike Hoover & Norm Tillman.

Ted Walton opened the meeting by greeting everyone and thanking the attendees for coming. He gave an overview of how the past two years have gone. He said it has been a good two years and hopes the WSAA will continue to grow in the right direction.

Financial Statement – Lynell Preston

The Financial statement was given showing a starting balance of \$9,032.27 as of March 6, 2010 and ending with a balance of \$9,764.42 as of October 2, 2010. Randy Wahler made a motion to accept the financial report as read and was seconded by Larry Baker. Financial report accepted.

Directors Report – Dan Kolb (filling in for Andy Turnquist)

Any agenda items that archers wish to be brought up at the NFAA Directors meeting, needs to be given to Andy Turnquist.

Our Northwest Sectional Councilman Dan Kolb is on the NFAA Board of Directors. He said that he will attend the Vegas shoot meeting, which will now be held every two years. The 2012 Vegas World Archery Festival may not be held at the Riviera. Dan says the committee is looking at different locations because their contract will expire. For now however, it will continue to be at the Riviera. He also brought up that during the archery festival there will be a half hour practice session before your time to shoot. This will allow archers to practice on their respective target butts

Dan brought up that, as per NFAA requirements the state has to host one indoor and one outdoor shoot for NFAA members only. More on this subject will come later in the minutes under new business.

Old Business

Lynell Preston and Larry Baker will continue to work on getting the Constitution and By-Laws updated and reviewed before putting them on the website.

The matter of plaques vs. money payback came up. This proposal was implemented for a 2 year trial period. It has been 2 years since the proposal for the flight system with cash paybacks was implemented. There was no motion to continue the cash payback option. The awards will now revert to the previous version of plaques or trophies until a new idea comes up and is voted on.

The WSAA will continue implementing the installation of a Board of Directors as stated in the Constitution and By-Laws. The Board of Directors will consist of the elected WSAA officers, and one representative from each affiliate club. The WSAA is asking all of the affiliate clubs to get with their respective members and chose a person to represent their club, serve as a communications liaison, come to the meetings and give a voice and a vote to their club. The club representatives for each club will be listed as the Board of Directors in the newsletter and on the website.

Randy Wahler has been appointed to be the alternate Director for the WSAA until the 2012 election.

Archer of the Year and Youth archer of the Year nominations need to be submitted no later than **January 15th, 2011**. If you know of anyone that you feel qualifies please let Lynell know by the **15th of January**.

Shooter of the Year has been and is being updated on the website. Michael Bean volunteered to get information to update scores.

New Business:

In order for the WSAA to be in compliance with the NFAA we must hold an indoor and an outdoor tournament and only allow NFAA members to participate. So it was discussed to have a shoot in conjunction with State Vegas and call it the Wyoming Open. Jeff Meyer made a motion to host the Wyoming Open in conjunction with State Vegas. This would allow all Wyoming NFAA members to compete and allow non members and WSAA only members to compete. Larry Baker seconded the motion – motion passed.

Jeff Meyer made a motion that the president would appoint a committee to administer the awards, and run the portion of the Wyoming Open that will be held in conjunction of the State Vegas. Shane Kinsel seconded the motion – motion passed.

State Field will be held in Casper. Jeff Meyer is working on getting things set up for that tournament.

Moving State Target-

Dan Perry made a motion to move State Target into the rotation; this would be to encourage more archers to attend. Larry Baker seconded – motion passed. Cheyenne will host State Target for 2011.

The WSAA is looking to find different ways to advertise the organization. We are looking for ideas such as sponsorships, increasing the personal value of belonging to the NFAA, etc. The WSAA is also looking for ideas to get more youth archers involved.

Nominations will be taken for the State officers for the term of 2011 - 2013. If you would like to nominate someone, please send the nomination in writing or email to any of the state officers. The nominations need to be sent in no later than March 5th. The election will take place at State Indoor by ballot and the officers will take office at State Field. This will be for the 2011 – 2013 term.

All nominations for the Bowhunters Honor roll, Archer of the Year, and Youth Archer of the Year, must be received no later than **January 15th 2011**. Please email or put in writing and mail all nominations to Lynell. Please don't wait until the last minute to get the nominations sent in.

Lifetime achievement award –

Ted Walton is to check into costs, awards, etc. to see what would make this award work.

Publicity Chairman –

The WSAA is looking for someone that would be interested. The duties of the Publicity Chairman shall have news items published in the WSAA newsletter and other news media. If you are interested please let the State Secretary know.

Ted says he has someone in mind that is interested.

The Shoot Schedule for the upcoming year is attached.

If there are any suggestions, comments, ideas, please bring them to one of the state officers.
